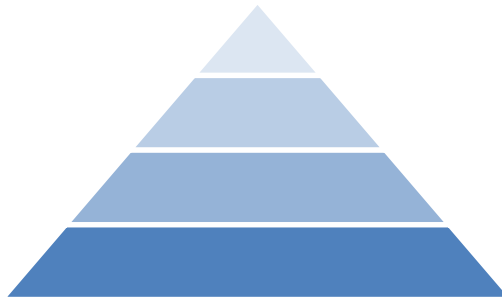

<p style="text-align: right;">2:15</p> <p><b>action –</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• present yourself before God</li> <li>• rightly handling the word of truth</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: right;">2:14, 16-18</p> <p><b>action –</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• quarrels about words</li> <li>• speaks irreverent babble</li> </ul>
<p><b>reaction –</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• no need to be ashamed</li> </ul>	<p><b>reaction –</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• does no good</li> <li>• ruins the hearers</li> <li>• leads to ungodliness</li> <li>• spreads like gangrene</li> </ul> <p>example: Hymanaeus and Philetus</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- swerved</li> <li>- upsetting the faith</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: right;">2:19</p> <p><b>God's firm foundation stands.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Seal #1 – The Lord knows those who are His - (2:19)</li> <li>• Seal #2 – Let everyone who names the name of the Lord</li> </ul>
