

**From Refugee to Rescuer**  
Matthew 2:13-15

Three Major Types of Prophecy Fulfillment

1. \_\_\_\_\_ fulfillment – a one-to-one messianic prediction fulfilled only by Jesus (2:6, cf. Micah 5:2).
2. \_\_\_\_\_ fulfillment – an event or description of Jesus that clearly summarizes an overall theme in OT prophecy (2:23, cf. Psalm 22, 69; Isaiah 53).
3. \_\_\_\_\_ fulfillment – Jesus fulfills, or completes, to the greatest degree, the purpose of God’s story (2:15, cf. Hosea 11:1-2).

“fulfill” (*pleroo*) -
