Paul’s 4 Headlines About Not Understanding His Own Actions

HEADLINE #1 – Radical Rule

- The flesh is sold under sin.

HEADLINE #2 – Righteous Riot

- Paul's flesh is mounting an attack against Paul's delight in the law of God.

HEADLINE #3 – Wretched Reverend

- Living under the Radical Rule during the Righteous Riot is miserable when Simon Sin wins.

HEADLINE #4 – Rescuing Redeemer

- Paul looks outside of himself and cries out for a Rescuer.
