## What is the purpose of these judgments?

- 1. God reveals the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_ as He judges the earth and its occupants in an increasing intensity (1/4, 1/3, all), sometimes simply allowing evil to run its course (6:4,8; 9:3,5; 13:5,7,14,15).
- God reminds his people that they are never \_\_\_\_\_\_; they are safe in his protection, yet some will witness to the Lamb as martyrs (3:10; 6:11; 7:1-8; 9:4, 11:7; 16:3).
- 3. God provides a final \_\_\_\_\_\_, yet many will refuse to worship the Lamb and prefer the very demonic forces that bring about their demise. God shows his wrath is just (9:20; 14:6-7; 15:3-4; 16:5-7,9,11).
- 4. God calls his people to follow the Lamb as missionary witnesses despite being \_\_\_\_\_\_ and, at times, \_\_\_\_\_\_ (11:1-13; 14:4-12).
- 5. God, in the end, will dismantle his creation in order to introduce his perfect (6:12-14; 16:17-21; 20:11; 21:1-5).
