

Midian is <u>overpowering</u>.

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- Israel is <u>hiding</u>.

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"And the hand of Midian overpowered Israel, and because of Midian the people of Israel made for themselves the dens that are in the mountains and the caves and the strongholds." (2)

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"And Israel was brought very low because of Midian. And the people of Israel cried out for help to the Lord." (6)

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"very low" = lit. "became small"

Episode #1 - God <u>comes</u>, and Gideon <u>wavers personally</u>.

"And the angel of the Lord appeared to him and said to him, 'The Lord is with you, O mighty man of valor." (12)

"And said to him, 'Please, my lord, if the Lord is with us, why then has all this happened to us? And where are all his wonderful deeds that our fathers recounted to us?" (13)

"And the Lord turned to him and said, 'Go in this might of yours and save Israel from the hand of Midian; do not I send you?" (14)

"And he said to him, 'Please, Lord, how can I save Israel? Behold, my clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my father's house." (15)

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* Gideon, tear down your father's altar of Baal -


