Living stones	Followers of Jesus who are like their foundation
Built up into a spiritual house	Arranged by an architect into a spiritual dwelling
Holy priesthood	Distinct servants of God
Spiritual sacrifices	Spiritual actions offered in thanks to God
Builders	People who select construction materials
Stone of stumbling/Rock of offense	Stone you trip over rather than stand on
