
Threat #2 - Listening to antichrist(s)

1 John 2:18


The last hour is a "theological assertion not a chronological indicator."



Maybe ... it is believable that one person with supernatural charisma could deceive the world through political, technological, and spiritual means.


Maybe ... it is also believable that the world is overtaken by a systemic power rather than a singular person.



"Father, the hour has come; glorify your Son that the Son may glorify you, since you have given him authority over all flesh, to give eternal life to all whom you have given him. "And this is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent ... "For I have given them the words that you gave me, and they have received them and have come to know in truth that I came from you; and they have believed that you sent me.

"I am praying for them ... Holy Father, keep them in your name, which you have given me, that they may be one, even as we are one ... "I do not ask that you take them out of the world, but that you keep them from the evil one. They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.

"Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth. As you sent me into the world, so I have sent them into the world ... "I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me.

"Father, I desire that they also, whom you have given me, may be with me where I am, to see my glory that you have given me because you loved me before the foundation of the world. "I made known to them your name, and I will continue to make it known, that the love with which you have loved me may be in them, and I in them."
