### Transportation

### What to Bring

### Spending Money

The camp Trading Post will be open during the week for campers to purchase snacks, drinks, tee shirts and other novelty items. We recommend around \$20 for spending money. We will collect all spending money before leaving and keep it in a camp bank so kids do not have to keep up with their money.

### Phones

No cell phones are allowed, and no public phones are present at Hickory Cove. Do not plan to talk with your child by phone while he or she is at camp. In case of an emergency, the NHC leaders will make sure parents are contacted.

### Rules

We will honor the camp rules of Hickory Cove Bible Camp:

- No cell phones, iPods, or other electronics
- No gum on the campsite
- No food or drinks in the sleeping quarters

### Dress Code

We will honor the dress code of Hickory Cove Bible Camp:

- Shorts must be mid-thigh length or longer
- Boys—no tank tops; shirts must be worn at all times except when in swimming pool
- Girls—no spaghetti strap tank tops; modest tankinis and one-piece swimsuits are permitted.
