"For if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you, but if you do not forgive others their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses."

Big Idea: Pray to your Father.

That God should be personally addressed as "Father"... was absolutely revolutionary in Jesus' day.

"The writers of the Old Testament certainly believed in the Fatherhood of God, but they saw it mainly in terms of a sovereign Creator-Father ... "You can search from Genesis to Malachi, and you will not find one individual speaking of God as Father ...

"But when Jesus came on the scene, he addressed God only as Father. He never used anything else! All his prayers address God as Father.

"The Gospels (just four books) record his using Father more than sixty times in reference to God.

"So striking is this that there are scholars who maintain that this word Father dramatically summarizes the difference between the Old and New Testaments.

"No one had ever in the entire history of Israel spoken and prayed like Jesus. No one!"


