Is Jesus establishing a *pope*? *No*.

- The NT never sets up a <u>supreme human leader</u>.
- o There is no biblical evidence *Peter* led the *church in Rome*.
- Doctrinal disputes were not resolved by Peter's supremacy.
- The church fathers did not recognize a supreme, infallible papacy.
- The papacy is supposedly vital for <u>blank</u>, but it has become a means of <u>blank</u>.

What is Jesus referring to? Three options.

- The rock is <u>Peter</u>.
- o The rock is *Peter's confession*.
- The rock is Christ.
 - * The rock is Peter in his confessing Christ.
- *Dates* (18b)
- Keys (19)
