



WHO are the enemies?

Satan, death, and fear are the enemies.

HOW does Jesus **destroy** the enemy?

"By embracing death, taking it into himself, he destroyed the Devil's hold on death and freed all who cower through life, scared to death of death."

Hebrews 2:14-15 (MSG)

HOW does Jesus <u>destroy</u> the enemy? By <u>suffering</u> and <u>dying</u> he destroys the enemy. "There is a nice symmetry in this: Death initially came by a man, and resurrection from death came by a man.

"Everybody dies in Adam; everybody comes alive in Christ . . . after crushing the opposition, he hands over his kingdom to God the Father.

"He won't let up until the last enemy is down
— and the very last enemy is death!

"As the psalmist said, 'He laid them low, one and all; he walked all over them.'"

1 Corinthians 15:21-25 (MSG)
