Who We're Looking For

The strongest candidate will genuinely love Christ, His church, and helping people grow as disciples. Because this position carries significant spiritual leadership and pastoral responsibility, the candidate must meet the biblical qualifications for an elder as outlined in 1 Timothy 3:1–7 and Titus 1:5–9, and be able to represent and teach North Hills Church's theological convictions and ministry positions with authentic agreement.

We are especially looking for someone who:

- Demonstrates spiritual maturity, humility, integrity, and a shepherd's heart.
- Has strong organizational and administrative skills and enjoys bringing clarity and order to ministry systems and processes.
- Is dependable and able to follow through consistently on details, people, and commitments.
- Relates well to a wide variety of people and can encourage, equip, and care for volunteer leaders.
- Can work collaboratively as part of a ministry team while taking ownership of assigned responsibilities.
- Communicates clearly and effectively, both personally and in group settings.
- Is comfortable managing multiple ministry responsibilities simultaneously without losing sight of individual people.
- Has experience in small group ministry, men's ministry, pastoral ministry, or volunteer leadership. Such experience would be beneficial but is not required for the right candidate.
